## OUR COLLABORATIVE INITIATIVES & PROGRAMS

By building strong, trusting relationships between Denton County businesses, governments, and nonprofits, our Collaborative Initiatives and Programs aim to address complex problems in our community like food insecurity, family financial instability, and mental illness.

We leverage these long-standing relationships to reimagine how we respond to our community's needs and build greater opportunity for every person in Denton County.

### ADVOCACY

Our priorities focus on the needs of our community to boost economic productivity, enhance self-sufficiency, and promote healthy families in North Texas.

### BOARD LEADERSHIP INSTITUTE

We teach local volunteers the skills needed to shape and govern a successful nonprofit organization.

### COMMUNITY NEEDS ASSESSMENT

We research, collate, and publish full reports every few years to determine Denton County's highest-priority needs. Annual updates assess changing trends.

### DENTON COUNTY BEHAVIORAL HEALTH LEADERSHIP TEAM

This Team advocates and facilitates a collaborative person-centered behavioral health system to repair and restore lives.

### DENTON COUNTY HOMELESSNESS LEADERSHIP TEAM

This Team fosters an effective and coordinated system of homelessness prevention and intervention to make homelessness rare, brief, and nonrecurring.

### DENTON COUNTY VETERANS CENTER

We collaborate with local Veteran service providers to maintain a suite of services for our Veterans in need.

### DENTON COUNTY WORKFORCE SUCCESS LEADERSHIP TEAM

This Team works to increase financial capabilities and earning potential for working families in Denton County to move them from survival to stability.

### DENTON COUNTY WORKS

We collate resources to bridge the gap between job seekers and employers with local job listings, useful tips, and workforce guidance.

### FREE TAX PREPARATION

We train community volunteers to provide free tax preparation to seniors and low to moderately low-income families.

### HOMELESSNESS DATA COMMUNITY DASHBOARD

We collate and analyze Coordinated Entry data from a county-wide network of shelters and service providers, as well as the annual one-day homeless population census, to better understand the nature of homelessness.

### HOMELESSNESS POINT IN TIME COUNT

The annual census of people experiencing homelessness by trained volunteers that provides a snapshot of the homeless experience on any given day.

### HOUSING NAVIGATION

We centralize communication between landlords and housing service agencies to increase access to safe and affordable housing for Denton County households in crisis.

### INFORMATION & REFERRAL

We help people in crisis through a local helpline, online database, and local resource directories to connect those in need with service providers in Denton County.

### PARTNER AGENCIES & NETWORK OF NONPROFITS

We amplify the efforts of highly efficient and effective nonprofits by investing resources and holistic support to address the most critical needs of Denton County.

### SENIOR HOUSING STABILITY

This program offers rental gap assistance to qualifying seniors.

### VETERAN CLINICAL COUNSELING

We help eligible Veterans, their surviving spouses, and dependents working through behavioral health challenges.

### WORKFORCE UPSKILLING

We develop process improvements between local nonprofits and Workforce Solutions of North Central Texas to increase earning potential of Denton County households.
