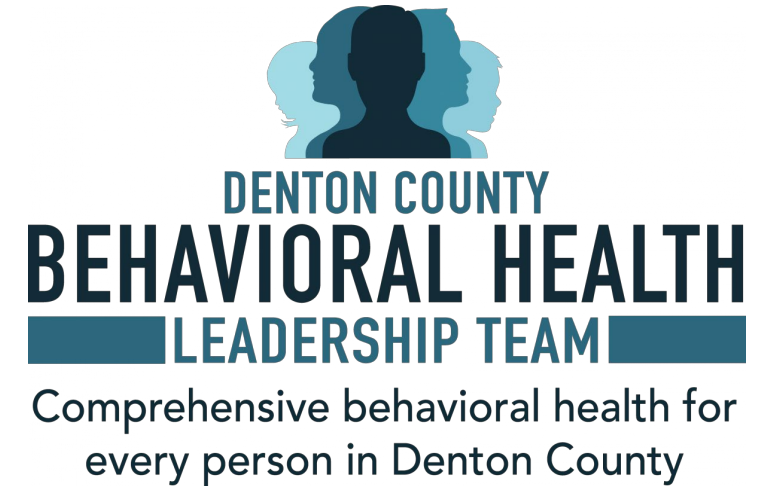
Program Overview

The Denton County Veteran Stability Program seeks to help eligible Veterans, their dependents and surviving spouses facing financial hardships with temporary assistance and connection to wraparound supportive services.

- Rent or Mortgage
- Utilities
- Transportation
- Employment & Job Training
- Education
- Critical Documents
- Childcare

Process Overview

Veterans, dependents, and surviving spouses are referred to Veteran Community Navigators via Veterans Referral Form on UWDC website

Veteran Community Navigators refer eligible participants to UWDC Veteran Center Coordinator

UWDC Veteran Center Coordinator completes application for financial assistance with household and gathers necessary eligibility & finance documentation

UWDC staff review application and approve or deny within 2 business days

Upon approval, UWDC disburses payments to vendors monthly on the 1st and 15th
